- c. Enrolled in an AA degree program (includes AA in Teaching and AA in Hawaiian Studies) selected AS degreewith an articulation agreement with a forgrear campus to a specific program (or current list, seeAS Degrees Accepted fourtAmatic Admission spreadsheet)
- d. GPA is 2.0 or above.
- e. Have greater than 50 credits that are including earned or in progress credits.
- f. Have greater nstitutional credits ( home campus) that are and above, incluing earned or in progress credits.
- g. STAR Grad Requirementors such as GPA and number of creidits) greater than or equal to 3 percent complete.
- h. STAR Core Requirements greater than or equal to 96 percent complete.
- i. Include students who were offered auto admission the previous semesterdid not respond or who declined theffer and are not currently enrolled in a foyear campus
- j. Exclude students who have already egree.
